Hi everyone,

I know many of you have your heads down and your fingers working on your NOFA applications. Sorry to interrupt you.

Sometime on Wednesday, you should have received a memo from me (via June) that detailed the possibility that additional funds and a contract extension for Housing Placement Program might be a possible result of an Emergency Proclamation by Governor Ige. It seems as though the EP might be issued, so I wanted to give you all an up-date on the funding.

You all received a 6 month contract (7/1/15-12/31/15) worth half of the amount you normally receive for an annual contract. The table below shows the additional funds you would receive for the 2nd 6 months of the contract (B) and the supplemental amount based on a pro-rata division of the additional funds being offered (\$500,000). Column D shows you what your total contract would be worth.

I need you all to determine whether or not you can effectively use the funds, especially the supplemental amount in C. You have no obligation to take all the money being offered, and can choose to simply get the amount in B and extend your contracts until 6/30/16. In that case, you might simply double your current service #s. If you accept any amount above that, your performance measures (#s served) would need to be increased as well.

Please think about this and respond to me by Tuesday, 10/20 so that my staff can begin working with you on contract extensions and the review of work plans and budgets. Although I will be on the road for the next three days, I will look at email regularly and try to respond. If we need to talk, please send me your numbers and the best time to reach you. I will do my best to answer all of your questions as I am able.

Thank you to all of you and your colleagues for working hard every single day. You are appreciated.
